Hapag-Lloyd/APL resumes the Asia-Mexico service and the first choice is CCT

On May 27th, 2008, the resumed Asia-Mexico Express (AME) service from Hapag-Lloyd / APL is calling at CCT. The purpose of resuming this service is to serve the shippers better and satisfy the needs of cargo increasing from Shenzhen western port to Mexico.

The AME service replaces the previous MAX service and still be managed both by Hapag-Lloyd and APL, and deploy six 4,000-plus TEU vessels on this service.

It calls at CCT every Tuesdays and the port rotation is Yokohama – CCT – Ningbo – Shanghai – Pusan – Yokohama – Ensenada – Manzanillo - Lazaro Cardenas - Ensenada.

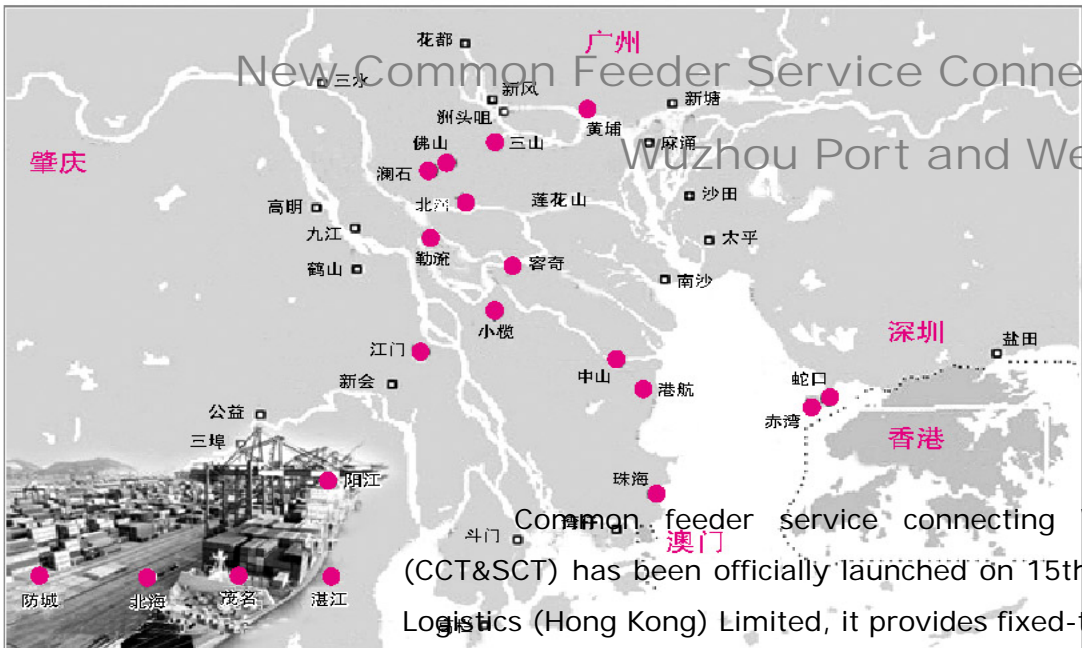
New Operation Mode for CCT Water way

transshipment outbound cargo goes well

The first batch of containers departed from Zhanjiang port to CCT/SCT following the new procedure of export trans-customs successfully since April 11, which means the commercial seal can be substituted for Customs seal. After this trial, with the support from PRD Customs, Leliu port in Shunde, Shenwan port, Zhongshan port, Zhongshan Sinotrans port, Jiuzhou port in Zhuhai, new mode was kicked off one after another. The new mode simplifies the trans-customs procedure by omitting the hoist for sealing at the original port for export container. So the operation efficiency is highly improved, so that the cost is reduced. This new mode provides the more convenient and effective barge service to customers and received more recognition from them.

New Common Feeder Service Connecting Wuzhou Port and Western SZ (CCT&SCT)

Common feeder service connecting Wuzhou Port and Western SZ (CCT&SCT) has been officially launched on 15th May, 2009 .Operated by Classic Logistics (Hong Kong) Limited, it provides fixed-time sailing per week, heading for CCT/SCT from Wuzhou Port every Saturday and round back to Wuzhou Port on Wednesday. The newly launched service is expected to provide positive contribution to advance the South China Common Feeder Association (SCCFA) service network and better serve the local liners, logistics companies and vendors by its efficient, economic and environmental water way.

The first-stage construction for CCT ERTG conversation has been finished in the early of this May.

The first-stage construction is started from February 14, 2008 formally that including building construction, trolley line construction, RTG conversation and so on. The "Oil to Electricity conversion" RTG started to put into



operation in the middle of May.

The ERTG has the advantages of automatic electricity adopting & off-circuit displacing, thus reduce the potential safety hazard. Besides, the automatic correcting error can also minimize the accidental collisions.

CCT has also made the simulation according to the environmental inspection figures,

it greatly reduces the emission of hazardous substances, which will benefit the public society. Besides, it also contributes the "Green Terminal" project for CCT.
